The Special Event of the President of the General Assembly's event, a CSW65 Side Event, "Political Leadership and Violence Against Women and Girls: Prevention First" was held on 23 March 2021. A highlight of the meeting was that the Representative from Liechtenstein announced that the country was putting a bill through parliament to ratify the Istanbul Convention.
